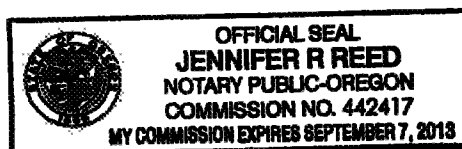

Alex Johnson/Emigh Design (S. Grant Emigh) Financial Agreement-November 28, 2010

1. This agreement addresses compensation of the past due balance on Account No. : 3617 of Marger Johnson & McCollom PC(MJM) for services and expenses in preparation of the US Patent Application and for the PCT (International) Patent Application filed in Emigh's behalf on May 7, 2010. The total balance owing is approximately \$29,000.

2. This agreement addresses how present balance is to be paid and future expenses are compensated and paid by Emigh.

A. Monthly payments of \$250.00 @0% annual interest rate will continue to be paid toward the past due balance until one or more of the following events is executed which satisfies the remaining past due balance:

d. From monies received from the sale of Omax Corp stock.


