WHEREAS, we are the inventors of certain new and useful improvements in **SUCROSE TRANSPORTER GENES FOR INCREASING PLANT SEED LIPIDS** for which an international application under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) has been filed in the Receiving Office of the United States Patent and Trademark Office and for which a U.S. application has been separately filed in the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. This Assignment is deemed to be effective at least as early as 11/23/09.






