ASSIGNMENT

I, Eckhard U. For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, I, the undersigned, have voluntarily sold, assigned, and transferred and do voluntarily sell, assign, and transfer to Board, its successors and assigns, the full and exclusive rights, title, and interest that are mine in and to the Inventions throughout the world, including the United States and its territorial possessions and in all foreign countries, including all rights to the applications and patents referenced above, and the rights to claim priority, in and to any and all improvements which are disclosed in said applications. This includes an assignment of my interest to all Letters Patents that may be granted on the Inventions in the United States of America and all countries throughout the world, and any divisional, renewal, continuation in whole or in part, substitution, conversion, reexamination, reissue, prolongation or extension thereof; and the right to claim priority from said patent applications as provided for by United States law, the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the European Patent Convention, the Paris Convention, or other applicable law; and the right to sue and recover damages for any past;

present, and future infringement of any of said Letters Patents.

I hereby authorize the Board to file and prosecute said patent applications referenced above, as well as any corresponding international or national applications that claim priority therefrom. Board has the right to select attorneys or agents of its choice to prosecute at its discretion these applications on its behalf. I authorize and request the issuance of said Letters Patents to Board, as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest of mine to be held as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by me had this assignment not been made.

I grant Board the power to insert on this Assignment any further information that may be necessary or desirable in order to comply with all applicable legal requirements, including the rules of the United States Patent and Trademark Office, for submitting and recording this document.

I warrant that (1) I have made no other assignment, transfer, or conveyance of my rights, title or interests in the Inventions; (2) this Assignment does not conflict with any rights of, any agreement by me with, or obligations or duties owed by me to any third party; (3) no other person or entity is entitled to claim any right, title, or interest in or to the Inventions by or through me, and (4) there are no outstanding assignments, grants, liens, encumbrances, or agreements either written, oral, or implied that will impair, diminish, limit, or abridge the interest herein conveyed at the time of the execution of the present assignment. I shall not communicate nor cooperate in any manner with any third party, other than Board, that claims any rights in and to the Inventions.

I also hereby assign to Board all rights, title and interest of mine to any improvements related to the Inventions to which the Board is entitled under the BOR Rules and agree to promptly and fully communicate to Board any facts and information known to me respecting any such improvements related to the Inventions while any patent application anywhere in the world is still pending that claims priority, whether directly or indirectly, from the Inventions or such application. I will maintain any such facts and information in confidence, I will only reveal such facts and information to Board or its assigns, and I will communicate such facts and information to the Office of Technology Commercialization at MD Anderson.

I also covenant that I will communicate to Board, its representatives, assigns or agents, any facts known to me respecting the Inventions or said applications, and to testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths, provide all requested documents, and do everything reasonably possible to aid Board and its assigns to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said Invention(s) or said application(s) in the United States or any foreign country. These provisions are binding upon my heirs, legal representatives, administrators and assigns.

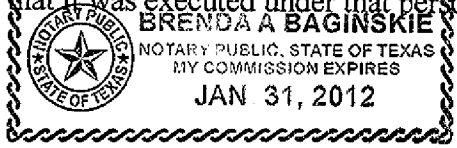
