
RECORDABLE PATENT ASSIGNMENT



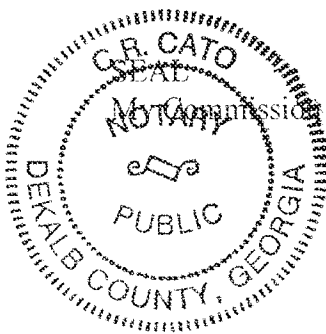
