Assignor agrees to execute such further papers and do such other acts as may be necessary to obtain, assign, renew, issue or enforce the aforementioned Scheduled Patents, including, but not limited to any acts which may be necessary, desirable or convenient for claiming said priority rights and perfecting Assignee's title in the aforementioned Scheduled Patents. Notwithstanding, Assignee shall have no duty to pay any renewal fees due or to pay the cost of drafting, editing, copying, mailing or any other associated cost in executing additional papers relating to the assignment of such Patents or trademarks.

In addition, Assignor assigns to Assignee all right title and interest in and to that certain Amended Default Judgment Against All Defendants entered on 10/25/09 in Adversary No. 09-06008-JDP styled *Rainsdon v. Anestel Corporation et. al.*, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit B.

Assignor makes no warranty of any kind in connection with the assignment. Said transfer is "AS-IS & WHERE IS" with Assignee making his own investigation as to any matters concerning said properties.

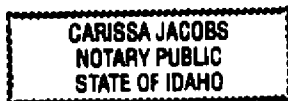

- An accounting of all royalties received or accrued including copies of the underlying licensing agreements of the Debtor and Defaulted Defendants;
- All legal or business agreements regarding licenses, royalty agreements, partnerships, patent disclosures of Defaulted Defendants; and
- A status of all patents held by Defaulted Defendants.

2. **AVOIDANCE OF INTERESTS IN PATENTS & TRADEMARKS:** Any and all claims of interest or ownership of Anestel Corporation f/k/a ConectL Test Corporation, Inovin Inc., f/k/a Exact Research, Inc., R-Tech Corporation, PNPC, Inc., Faris McMullin, Michael McMullin, and Michael McDonagh are avoided in and to patents, royalties, foreign patents, copyrights, trademarks, and license agreements related to but not limited to:


