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ASSIGNMENT



I agree to execute any and all further documents required by the Company, its successors or assigns, for the prosecution of the Application, or of any division,



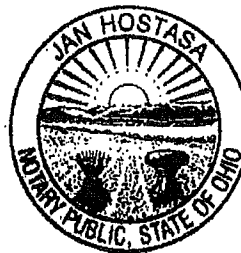
