ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, University of Hawaii, a body corporate and public instrumentality of the state of Hawaii and acting through its Office of Technology Transfer and Economic Development located at 2800 Woodlawn Drive, Suite 280, Honolulu, Hawaii 96822 (hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNOR) has certain rights in the invention entitled "Suppression Of Alternative Telomere Lengthening (ALT) Mechanism By Reverse Transcriptase Inhibitors," having the invention disclosure date of January 7, 2002 and TLG # 355, for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on January 15, 2003 and has been assigned a U.S. patent application number 60/440,988 (hereinafter the "Invention"); and
