ASSIGNMENT AND LICENSE AGREEMENT

This agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") entered into and effective as of the last date of execution hereof is by and among: Lin A. Jakary, Trustee of the John R. Wells Trust, u/d/t dated December 11, 1996, (hereinafter "the Trust") having a place of business at 551 Gravilla Street, La Jolla, California 92037; Accord Technologies, LLC (hereinafter "Accord"), a Massachusetts limited liability company having its place of business at 77 Accord Park Drive, D-7, Norwell, Massachusetts 02061; and Harvest Technologies Corporation (hereafter "Harvest"), a Massachusetts corporation having its place of business at 77 Accord Park Drive, D-7, Norwell, Massachusetts 02061 (collectively referred to hereinafter as "the parties").

WHEREAS, the Trust is the successor to the rights of John R. Wells, an individual doing business as BioSystems Development Company, in a development agreement with Level 1 Technologies, Inc., which was executed on August 19, 1994, and amended on August 29, 1994 ("Development Agreement");

WHEREAS, Harvest is the successor in interest to all rights and obligations of Level 1 Technologies, Inc. in connection with said Development Agreement;

WHEREAS, Accord desires to acquire all rights of the Trust in said Development Agreement and any rights of the Trust in the technology represented by the Licensed Patents (as defined below); and

WHEREAS the Trust wishes to obtain a license under Licensed Patents in the Licensed Field as defined herein;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and understandings hereinafter set forth, the parties intending to be legally bound do hereby agree as follows:

DEFINITIONS

1. "Licensed Patents" shall mean the patents and patent applications set forth on the attached Exhibit A and any continuations, divisions, reexaminations, or reissues thereof.

ASSIGNMENT

3. The Trust hereby assigns to Accord any and all right, title and interest throughout the world in and to the Licensed Patents including all its right title and interest in and to the inventions described and/or claimed therein and the right of action for past infringement that it currently holds.

23. Each party represents and warrants that the undersigned person has the full authority of the respective party to enter into this Agreement.


ENTIRE AGREEMENT


