ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment, effective as of 12/21/2010, is executed by **MITCH PRUST**, an individual residing at 326 Spring Street, St. Paul, MN 55102 (“**Assignor**”) in favor of **TITANIDE VENTURES, LLC**, a Texas limited liability company having an office at 911 NW Loop 281, Suite 211-30, Longview, TX 75604 (hereinafter “**Assignee**”).

BACKGROUND

A. ASSIGNMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which is hereby acknowledged:

1. Assignment Generally. Assignor, by these presents does hereby irrevocably assign, transfer and convey to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, the entire right, title, and interest throughout the world in, to, and under the Assigned Property, including all (a) inventions, (b) patents, (c) patent applications (including all patents that may be granted thereon), (d) all divisions, continuations, reissues, reexaminations, renewals, and extensions of such patents, and (e) all rights of priority under international conventions and applications for letters patent that may hereafter be filed for such inventions, applications and patents in any country or countries. Assignor retains no interest in the Assigned Property.

2. Assignment of Prior Claims. Assignor by these presents does hereby assign, transfer,; and convey to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, all claims for damages and all remedies arising out of any violation of the Assigned Property and other rights assigned hereby that may have accrued prior to the date of assignment to Assignee, or may accrue hereafter, including the right to sue for, collect, and retain damages for past, present or future infringements of all or any part of the Assigned Property.

3. Instruction. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any official of any country foreign to the United States whose duty it is to issue patents on applications included in the Assigned Property, to issue all letters patent therefor and all letters patent resulting from the applications and the patents included in the Assigned Property, to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Assignment.

4. Further Assurances. Assignor agrees to execute, deliver and record, without charge to but at the request and expense of Assignee, all additional papers, and take such additional actions, necessary or useful in order to give effect to the assignment of the Assigned Property as set forth in this Assignment and to otherwise carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this Assignment. Without limiting the foregoing, Assignor will, for all countries, (a) provide to Assignee all facts known to Assignee relating to the Assigned Property and the history thereof and (b) testify in all legal proceedings and generally do everything possible which Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, shall consider desirable for aiding in securing, maintaining and enforcing the Assigned Property, including proper patent and other protections for the Assigned Property and vesting all title to the Assigned Property in Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns.

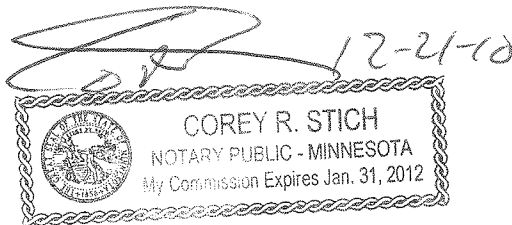
