DEED OF ASSIGNATION

THIS ASSIGNATION is made the 3rd day of JUNE 2011
between THE UNIVERSITY COURT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF EDINBURGH, whose
full post office address is Old College, South Bridge, Edinburgh, Scotland EH8 9YL ("the
Assignor") and ROSLIN FOUNDATION, whose full post office address is Roslin
BioCentre, Roslin, Midlothian, Scotland, EH25 9PP ("the Assignee").

WHEREAS

(A) the Assignor is the owner of the entire right, title and interest to and in the
invention ("the Invention") which is the subject of US Patent Application No. 11/817,652
filed on 3 March 2006 and identified in the books of Kilburn & Strode LLP as P38441US-
M ("the Application");

(B) the Assignor and Assignee have executed an Assignment and Revenue Sharing
Agreement dated 23 February 2011;

NOW THIS ASSIGNATION WITNESSETH

1) It is the wish of the parties hereto to assign the Invention and the Application to
the Assignee and to confirm that the Application should be prosecuted in the name of the
Assignee and that any corresponding applications (corresponding applications defined as
any applications claiming priority from the Application under the International
Convention or any other patent treaty or convention, divisional, continuation, or
continuation-in-part applications) filed elsewhere in the world should be filed in the name
of the Assignee and that any patent granted on the Application or the corresponding
applications shall vest in the Assignee:


(i) the benefit of the Invention and the Application, all right, title and
interest therein and all the rights, powers, liberties and immunities
belonging thereto or accrued therefrom (including the right to apply for or

obtain corresponding patents for the Invention in any country of the world together with the right to claim priority from the Application under the International Convention or any other patent treaty or convention) to the intent that any patent granted pursuant to the Application or any other application corresponding to the Application shall be in the name of and vested in the Assignee to HOLD unto the Assignee absolutely; and

2) This Deed of Assignment shall be construed in all respects in accordance with Scottish law.

IN WITNESS whereof the parties hereto have caused this Deed of Assignment to be duly executed on the day and year first above written.


