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ASSIGNMENT



improvements and any of said inventions, and all applications for foreign patents or other certificates of protection for said improvements and any of said inventions, and to perform, but without cost or expense to me, all acts necessary or expedient to secure to said assignee patent or other protection for said improvements and any of said inventions in the United States and in all foreign countries selected by the said assignee, as fully and entirely as the same might have been secured by me had this Assignment not been made.


