
1 order appointing a third party to execute the assignment of certain patent rights owned by

3 judgment previously confirmed by this Court.

4 **THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:**

5 1. Robbin L. Itkin of Steptoe & Johnson LLP is appointed and authorized, as an
6 officer of this Court, for the sole and limited purpose of signing in the name of Shanghai ELE
7 one or more Assignments, in substantially the form attached hereto, of the patent applications
8 and patents listed in the Declaration of Peter Vogel to the purchaser(s) of such assets at an
9 execution sale directed by the U.S. Marshal in a manner consistent with the California Code of
10 Civil Procedure sections 701.510, *et seq.*, and any and all other documents reasonably necessary
11 to convey all right, title, and interest of Shanghai ELE Manufacturing Corp. therein to such
12 purchaser(s); and neither Ms. Itkin nor Steptoe & Johnson LLP or any member or employee
13 thereof shall be liable for the ownership, validity, enforceability, maintenance, value or condition
14 of the patents that are the subject of the Assignments or the Assignments themselves.

15 2. Steptoe & Johnson LLP's bill, up to but not exceeding \$20,000, will be allowed
16 as a cost of sale pursuant to California Code of Civil Procedure section 701.810(f)(1). If
17 Bingham is the purchaser, its bid must include cash sufficient to pay this and any other allowed
18 costs of sale.
