**PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT**

THIS PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT (the "Agreement"), is made and entered into this 14th day of February, 2008 (the "Effective Date"), by and between Snap-on Incorporated, Snap-on Equipment Ltd. ("Assignor") and TT IP, LLC ("Assignee"), a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Texas (each a "Party" and collectively the "Parties").

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements of the Parties and pursuant to the Purchase Agreement, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is hereby agreed as follows:


**I. ASSIGNMENT**

1. Assignor hereby sells, transfers, assigns and sets over to Assignee all rights, title and interest (for all countries) in and to the Patents and Related Patents, and applications identified on Schedule A, Schedule B and Schedule C.


filed, as may be applicable, and to invoke and claim such right of priority without further written or oral authorization from Assignor.


