**DEED of
ASSIGNMENT and LICENCE**

PARTIES

- (1) **BRITISH TELECOMMUNICATIONS public limited company** (Registered No 1800000) whose registered office address is at 81 Newgate Street, London EC1A 7AJ, England ("BT"); and
- (2) **Psytechnics Limited** (Registered No 4110724) whose registered office address is at Fraser House, 23 Museum Street, Ipswich, Suffolk, IP1 1HN, England ("Psytechnics")

RECITALS

- (A) The Parties have entered into a licence agreement ("**Licence Agreement**") dated 22 December 2000, under which, among other things, Psytechnics was granted certain licences with respect to certain Patents and Software belonging to BT.
- (B) Pursuant to the Licence Agreement, the licence grant, with respect to those Patents designated as Core Patents, was a sole licence subject to certain conditions set out therein.
- (C) By separate agreement (Side Letter) between Psytechnics and BT, certain of the Core Patents were abandoned and/or allowed to lapse resulting in a reduction in the number of licensed patents.
- (D) After a new round of funding for Psytechnics, the parties and others have entered into a new investment agreement dated 20 April 2006 ("**Investor Rights Agreement**") pursuant to which and in certain pre-agreed circumstances, BT, will assign to Psytechnics certain Software and Core Patents all subject to the terms of this Assignment Agreement.

Now therefore in consideration of the mutual promises set out herein, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. Definitions and Interpretation

- 1.1 Words and expressions used in this Assignment Agreement shall take their meaning from the Licence Agreement except as defined herein. If there is any conflict between the two agreements, this Assignment Agreement shall take precedence but only with respect to the subject matter hereof. The following words and expressions shall have the following meanings:

Assignment Agreement this Assignment Agreement and the assignment as set out in Clause 2 below.

Assigned Core Patents	all Core Patents, including any continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional or extension and foreign counterparts and equivalents thereof.
BT Group	shall mean all Subsidiaries and Holding Companies of BT and all Subsidiaries of such Holding Companies from time to time, where the terms Subsidiaries and Holding Companies shall take their meaning from s735 and s735A of the Companies Act 1985 as supplemented by s144 of the Companies Act 1989.
Business Plan	means the business plan of Psytechnics as at the date of execution of the Investor Rights Agreement.
Core Patents	means those Patents and/or applications identified in Schedule A Part B.
Encumbrances	means all licences, permissions, consents and other rights existing in any of the Assigned Core Patents or Software.
Licence	the licence granted to BT and the BT Group pursuant to Clause 3 below.
Licensed Purposes	means the carrying out of any business as contemplated by the Business Plan, including, without limitation, the measurement, design, optimisation, correction, allocation, and assurance of media and/or communications services, devices and/or networks using perceptual engineering techniques;
Side Letter	an agreement dated 3 February 2003 between Psytechnics and BT regarding patents and their maintenance or discontinuation.
Software	the Software as defined in the Licence Agreement as listed in Schedule A Part A.
Sole Licensed Purposes	means the Licensed Purposes so far as they relate to audio perception applications.

2. Assignment

- 2.1 In consideration of the payment by Psytechnics to BT of £1.00 (One pound sterling), and such other full and valuable consideration identified herein, and subject to the Encumbrances, BT hereby assigns to Psytechnics:
- all of its rights, title and interest in the copyrights existing within the Software; and
 - the Assigned Core Patents including all of its rights of action, powers and benefits accrued or accruing in respect of any of them.
- 2.2 Upon execution of this Assignment Agreement the provisions of clauses 6.3.12; 6.4; 7.6 and 8 as set forth in the Licence Agreement shall immediately cease to have all force and effect to the extent they apply to the Assigned Core Patents.

3. Licence

- 3.1 In consideration of the assignment from BT to Psytechnics pursuant to Clause 2 above, and such other full and valuable consideration identified herein, Psytechnics hereby grants to BT (and the BT Group) a non-exclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, royalty-free licence under the Software and the Assigned Core Patents, to use, copy, load, store, and make any of them, but only for:
- a. internal research and development purposes in respect of the Sole Licensed Purposes without the right to sub-license; and
 - b. any purpose whatsoever including the right to sub-license outside of the Sole Licensed Purposes.
- 3.2 Psytechnics does not warrant or represent either expressly or by implication that it has the right to grant such licences or that BT's use of the rights licensed to it will not infringe the rights of any third party.
- 3.3 The rights granted to BT and the BT Group under this clause 3 are personal and may not be assigned.

4. Warranties

- 4.1 BT hereby represents and warrants to Psytechnics that:
- 4.1.1 it is the sole legal equitable and beneficial owner of the Assigned Core Patents and the copyright existing within Software;
 - 4.1.2 the Intellectual Property Rights in the Assigned Core Patents and Software are free from any security, charge, pledge or lien and the Licensor has paid all fees relating thereto up to date;
 - 4.1.3 since the date of the Investor Rights Agreement, BT has not granted licences to third parties that would, on execution of this Assignment Agreement fall outside the scope of the Licence granted to BT under Clause 3.1 above;
 - 4.1.4 so far as BT is aware, the Intellectual Property Rights and the validity or subsistence of BT's right, title and interest therein, is not the subject of any current, pending or threatened challenge, claim or proceeding, including for opposition, cancellation, revocation or rectification, and has not been the subject of any such challenge, claim or proceeding, and there are no known facts or matters which may give rise to any such challenge, claim or proceeding, except to the extent that such challenge, claim or proceeding has occurred since the date of the Investor Right Agreement and has been disclosed to Psytechnics; and
 - 4.1.5 none of the Intellectual Property has been wrongfully or unlawfully acquired by BT.
- 4.2 Psytechnics hereby represents and warrants that it shall use its reasonable endeavours to maintain the Assigned Core Patents in force and will not sell, lease, hire or license or otherwise encumber the Software (including any copyrights within it) or the Assigned Core Patents to the extent that such dealing would frustrate, prohibit or avoid any of the Licence granted hereunder (but for the avoidance of doubt Psytechnics may deal with the Software in any manner which does not have such affect on the Licence).

- 4.3 Except as expressly set forth in this Clause 4, neither BT nor Psytechnics makes any warranties or representations of any kind, whether express or implied or statutory (a) that any patents will issue from any pending patent application assigned hereunder, (b) as to the validity of any patent that may issue from any pending application, or the scope of any claims thereof, or (c) that the exploitation of any patents or patent applications assigned hereunder will not result in the infringement of any other patent or intellectual property right anywhere in the world.

5. Further Assistance

- 5.1 BT covenants that upon request from Psytechnics, BT will promptly execute all documents and do all acts that Psytechnics shall reasonably require to perfect the assignment and to ensure such intellectual property rights vest in Psytechnics completely and absolutely. Psytechnics shall reimburse BT's reasonable costs incurred in complying with any such request.
- 5.2 Psytechnics covenants that upon request from BT, Psytechnics will promptly execute all documents and do all acts that BT shall reasonably require to register or otherwise record for the public record the grant to BT of the License. BT shall reimburse Psytechnics reasonable costs incurred in complying with any such request.
- 5.3 BT agrees to give Psytechnics such assistance as Psytechnics may reasonably require and at Psytechnics' sole and entire expense to enable or assist Psytechnics to bring any action for infringement of the Assigned Core Patents against a third party.
- 5.4 BT shall make available to Psytechnics at the reasonable request and at the sole and entire expense of Psytechnics all of its files and records, original and copy text, materials and documents carrying or containing any official prosecution history relating to the Assigned Core Patents. BT shall have the right to retain and use copies of such files and information as reasonably required in accordance with this Assignment Agreement.

6. Waiver of Moral Rights

BT hereby irrevocably and unconditionally waives and shall procure the waiver by relevant BT employees of all those rights set out in Part I, Chapter IV, Moral Rights, of the United Kingdom Copyright Designs and Patents Act 1988 as amended and any similar rights of authors in the copyrights subsisting in the Software.

7. Disposal or Discontinuation of Assigned Core Patents

Solely in respect of the Assigned Core Patents, including divisions, continuations, continuations in part, and reissues thereof, Psytechnics will determine in what countries to obtain and retain patent protection. Psytechnics will provide BT with written notice of any decision not to seek or to abandon patent protection in a country, and, if so requested in writing by BT, sent within 30 days of such notice, BT, at its own expense, will be given the opportunity to proceed with any patent proceedings that are abandoned by Psytechnics. Psytechnics will assign to BT for a nominal consideration all rights to any patent application and patent for which BT assumed prosecution or maintenance after a notice from Psytechnics of its intent to abandon the patent or application.

8. Notices

Any and all notices pursuant to this Assignment Agreement shall be in writing and signed by (or by some person duly authorised by) the party giving it and may be served by leaving it at, or sending it by registered post, air mail or facsimile (confirmed by registered post or air mail) or by hand to the address of the relevant recipient party set out below (or as otherwise notified from time to time hereunder). Any notice so served by facsimile or by hand shall be deemed to have been received on the next working day after the notice has, respectively, been transmitted or received. Any notice so served by registered post or air-mail shall be deemed to have been received 5 business days after the notice has been posted. In proving:

- (a) delivery by hand, it shall be necessary only to produce a receipt for the communication signed by or on behalf of the addressee;
- (b) delivery by post, it shall be necessary only to prove that the communication was contained in an envelope which was duly addressed and posted in accordance with this clause; and
- (c) delivery by fax, it shall be necessary only for the fax communication to have been delivered by hand or sent by first class post on the same day but failure of the addressee to receive such confirmation shall not invalidate the relevant communication deemed given by fax.

9 Law

This Assignment Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English Law and subject to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

10 Third Parties

No person which is not a party to this Assignment Agreement shall have any right to enforce any of its terms pursuant to the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act 1999.

11 Effectiveness

- 11.1 This Assignment Agreement shall be a binding obligation of the Parties as of the date hereof but, subject to Section 11.2, this Assignment Agreement is subject to, and shall not become effective until, the Closing (as defined in that certain Share Purchase Agreement, dated of even date herewith, by and among Psytechnics, BT and the other Selling Members named therein, NetScout Systems A.C. UK Limited, a private company limited by shares, registered under the laws of England and Wales (company number 7478497) and the other parties named therein (the "Purchase Agreement")).
- 11.2 In the event that the Purchase Agreement is terminated prior to the Closing (as defined in the Purchase Agreement), this Assignment Agreement shall be deemed void and of no further force and effect.
