ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Andreas Foerster of Doerfles-Esbach, Germany, Norbert Fischer of Meeder, Germany, and Michael Feisthauer of Meeder, Germany, hereinafter ("Assignors"), have invented certain new and useful improvements in FILTER ELEMENT AND COMPRESSED AIR FILTER FOR SEPARATING FOREIGN MATTER FROM A COMPRESSED AIR STREAM for which application for a U.S. Patent was made on June 8, 2011 as U.S. Patent Application No. 13/155,895 based on PCT International Application No. PCT/EP2009/067529 filed December 18, 2009 which claims priority to German Patent Application No. 10 2008 054 878.2 filed December 18, 2008.

Assignors further covenant and agree that, at the time of the execution and delivery of these presents, Assignors possess full title to the invention and application

above-mentioned, and that they have the unencumbered right and authority to make this assignment.

Assignors further covenant and agree, and likewise binds their heirs, legal representatives and assigns, to promptly communicate to said Assignee or its representatives any facts known to them relating to said invention, to testify in any interference or legal proceedings involving said invention, to execute any additional papers which may be requested to confirm the right of the Assignee, its representatives, successors and assigns to secure patent or similar protection for the said invention in all countries and to vest in the Assignee complete title to the said invention and Letters Patent, without further compensation, but at the expense of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.




