STATEMENT OF ATTORNEY'S LIEN

The Affiant, William S. Parks, having been first duly sworn, states as follows:

1. The Affiant is Counsel to the firm of Wyatt, Tarrant & Combs, LLP, (the "Lienholder"), with a principal place of business at 1715 Aaron Brenner Drive, Suite 800, Memphis, Tennessee, 38120, and has been authorized by the Lienholder to make this statement on its behalf.


2. As used in this statement, the term "Patent Application" shall mean and refer to United States Patent Application No. 11/453,502, filed on June 15, 2006, entitled "Composite Materials Including Amorphous Thermoplastic Fibers."

3. The Patent Application is owned by Innegrity, LLC, a South Carolina limited liability company (the "Owner") through assignment from the inventor, Brian G. Morin.

4. Lienholder provided patent prosecution services to and provided payment of upfront costs for Owner with regard to the Patent Application under the agreement with Owner that Lienholder would be paid for such services and recompensed for such costs. Lienholder properly invoiced Owner for such services and costs and Owner does not dispute such invoice amounts. Owner paid Lienholder a certain amount for such services and costs; however, Owner remains in arrears and owing to Lienholder an amount of \$3,750.00 for unpaid legal service fees and \$960.00 for unpaid costs, against which there are no just credits or offsets known to the Affiant.

5. In order to secure payment of the sum described in paragraph 4, the Lienholder hereby asserts an attorney's retaining lien on the above-referenced property for all funds to which it is entitled for its services and costs incurred in support of the Patent Application.




