

20 Petitioner, CAMERON J. WEBB, as Administrator of the estate of James Webber  
21 Webb, deceased, having filed the Amended First and Final Account and Report of  
22 Administrator, Petition and its settlement, for allowance of attorneys fees for ordinary  
23 services; for allowance of attorneys fees for extraordinary fees; for ordinary commission to  
24 administrator and for Final Distribution; said Petition coming on November 2, 2005, regularly  
25 for hearing, in Division 1, the Honorable Deanne Smith Myers, judge  
26 presiding, the Court finds:

ORDER ON AMENDED FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT  
1

1. Due notice for the hearing on Petition has been regularly given, within the period and manner prescribed by law.

2. JAMES WEBBER WEBB died testate on August 21, 2003, and at the time of his death was a resident of the County of Los Angeles, California

3. Petitioner, CAMERON J. WEBB, qualified as Administrator of decedent's estate and Letters of Administration were issued to him on October 8, 2003.

4. An Inventory and Appraisement was filed in this estate on December 2, 2003, indicating assets of two parcels of real property located valued at \$1,975,000.00. On May 21, 2004 a Supplemental Inventory and Appraisal was filed listing certain vehicles in the amount of \$46,600.00 and on August 5, 2004, an additional Supplemental Inventory and Appraisal was filed showing patents valued at \$42,653.00.

5. Creditor's claims have filed or presented in this estate are as follows:

- a) Keith Halsey filed a claim for \$100,000.00 on April 23, 2004.
- b) John Groom filed a claim for \$536,215.00 on April 10, 2004.
- c) Fleet Credit Card Services filed a claim for \$17,189.47 on February 6, 2004.
- d) American Express filed a claim for \$14,088.58 on February 6, 2004.
- e) Bank One filed a claim for \$9,567.95 on February 17, 2004.
- f) Bank One filed a claim for \$11,384.22 on February 17, 2004.
- g) Bank One filed a claim for \$14,777.92 on April 8, 2004.
- h) Bay Cities National Bank filed a claim for \$37,894.21 on October 2, 2003.
- i) Comerica Bank filed a claim for \$712,293.98 on October 1, 2003.

6. All expenses of administration, funeral, burial, and medical incurred have been paid with funds outside of this estate by Petitioner who is not seeking reimbursement from this estate.

ORDER ON AMENDED FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT

1 7. No personal property taxes are due. No California and Federal income taxes have  
2 been paid. There are insufficient assets of the estate to pay these taxes. Federal and California  
3 estate tax returns have been filed, and no tax is due because the estate is not sufficient to cause a  
4 tax to be generated.

5 8. There is one unpaid secured judgment lien against the Estate which was owned by  
6 Comerica. This was purchased by Mr. Mark Silberberg. <sup>INDUSTRY CROSSOUTS.COM, INC</sup> The parties have agreed that Mr. <sup>INDUSTRY</sup>  
7 Silberberg would receive the sum of \$100,000 to be paid to Mr. Silberberg as partial payment for <sup>AGAINST</sup>  
8 <sup>ITS</sup> his secured debt.

9 9. In addition to his ordinary services as attorney for the Administrator and the  
10 Estate, John M. Gustafson has performed extraordinary services in the administration of this  
11 Estate and has requested fees for those services in the amount of \$50,000. Cameron Webb has  
12 agreed to reduce his statutory fees to \$26,045 and is not asking for extraordinary fees. John  
13 Groom has performed accounting services for the Estate and is to receive \$10,000.

14 It is THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

- 15 1. Administration of this estate is terminated;
- 16 2. Petitioner is discharged as Administrator of this estate;
- 17 3. The Administrator is ordered to pay to Mr. Mark Silberberg <sup>INDUSTRY CROSSOUTS</sup> \$100,000 as  
18 <sup>AGAINST ITS</sup> partial payment for his secured debt;
- 19 4. The Administrator is ordered to pay to John M. Gustafson \$50,000 for  
20 his services as attorney for the Estate;
- 21 5. The Administrator is ordered to pay to Cameron J. Webb \$26,045 for  
22 his services as Administrator;
- 23 6. The Administrator is ordered to pay to John Groom \$10,000 for  
24 accounting services performed on behalf of the Estate;
- 25 7. The sale of the Patents described on Exhibit 2, be confirmed to be owned  
26 by the bona fide purchasers; <sup>SUBJECT TO ANY SUPERIOR CLAIMS.</sup>  
27 <sup>OR LIENS.</sup>

28 ORDER ON AMENDED FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT

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8. All the acts and proceedings of Petitioner as Administrator are confirmed and approved;

9. Distribution of the estate of said decedent and any other property of decedent or the estate not now known but later discovered, to be distributed to ~~Cameron I. Webb, the only heir of the decedent.~~ TO INDUSTRY CLOSEOUTS.
