Quitclaim From Immersive Media Company to Immersive Media of Texas, LLC

WHEREAS, in an April 5, 2011 Assignment Agreement (referred to herein as “Long Form Agreement”), Immersive Media Company (referred to as “Assignor”), an Oregon corporation having a mailing address at, 3 Centerpoint Drive, Suite 250, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97035 sold, assigned, and transferred to Immersive Media of Texas, LLC (referred to as “Assignee”), a Texas limited liability company, having an office at 140 E Tyler St., Ste. 250, Longview, TX 75601, its successors, and assigns, for valuable and legally sufficient consideration, the entire right, title and interest in and to U.S. Patent Nos. 6,141,034 (titled “Immersive imaging method and apparatus”); 7,511,764 (titled “Digital Camera Synchronization”); 7,312,816 (titled “Digital Observation System”); 7,298,397 (titled “Digital Transmission System”); and all related patent applications, corresponding foreign patents and foreign patent applications, and all continuations, continuations in part, divisions, extensions, renewals, reissues and re-examinations relating to all inventions thereof (collectively, the “Patents”).

WHEREAS, the Long Form Agreement did not identify the address and jurisdiction of incorporation of Immersive Media Company.

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2011, Assignor Immersive Media Company executed a short form version (referred to as “Short Form Agreement”) of the Long Form Agreement, and the Short Form Agreement was submitted to the United States Patent and Trademark Office.

WHEREAS, the Short Form Agreement includes a clerical error in that it incorrectly identifies the jurisdiction of incorporation and address of Immersive Media Company as “a Canadian corporation having a mailing address at 224-15th Avenue SW Calgary, AB T2R 0P6, Canada” instead of the correct jurisdiction of incorporation and address of Immersive Media Company: an Oregon corporation having a mailing address at 3 Centerpoint Drive, Suite 250, Lake Oswego, Oregon 97035 (and a former mailing address at 2407 SE 10th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97214).

WHEREAS, Immersive Media Company and Immersive Media of Texas, LLC are both desirous of removing any uncertainties created by this clerical error and of quieting title in and to the Patents such that Immersive Media of Texas, LLC is the sole and exclusive owner of all right, title, and interest in the Patents.

NOW, THEREFORE, to quiet title in the Patents, for valuable and legally sufficient consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Immersive Media Company hereby quitclaims, assigns, and transfers to Immersive Media of Texas, LLC any right, title and interest in the Patents that Immersive Media Company may have retained, if any, throughout the Universe, including any and all rights (including causes of action for damages) associated with infringements of the Patents; the same to be held and enjoyed by Immersive Media of Texas, LLC for its own use and enjoyment, and for its successors and assignees, to the full end of the term for which the Patents are granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Immersive Media Company had this quitclaim not been made.




