2. Further Assurances. Each Party will take such further actions and execute promptly such further documents as are necessary to effect and record the above assignment, including any actions or documents required by the applicable registrar to document the transfer herein or as may be necessary to protect, secure and vest good, valid, and marketable title to the Patents and related rights in BUYER.
3. Recording of Assignment. SELLER hereby authorizes and requests the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO"), and any officer of any country or countries foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue Patents or other evidence or forms of intellectual property protection or applications, to issue the

same to BUYER and BUYER's successors, assigns, and other legal representatives in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

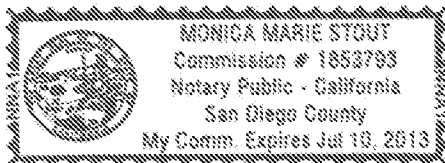

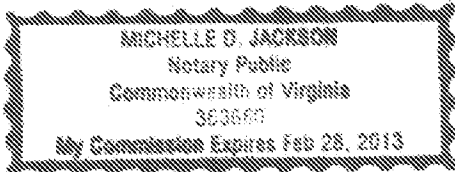
