EXTRACT OF PATENT ASSIGNMENT

Further, Assignor sold assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents does hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over, unto Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, all rights to bring actions at law or in equity for the past, present and future infringements, misappropriations or other violations of the '822 Patent, including all income, royalties, damages, payments, accounts and accounts receivable now or hereafter due and/or payable under and with respect thereto.

Assignor hereby authorizes and requests that the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States to issue any reissue patents from the '822 Patent to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this Extract.




