application and/or otherwise take advantage of the provisions of any international convention, treaty and/or agreement;

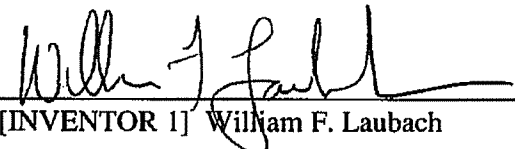

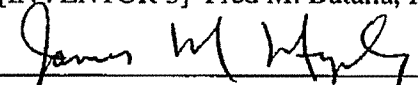
