ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Deborah Lewinsohn and David Lewinsohn (hereinafter "THE LEWINSOHNS"), of Portland, Oregon, citizens of the United States of America, executed an assignment of PCT Application No. PCT/US2007/006472, entitled "METHODS FOR PRODUCING AN IMMUNE RESPONSE TO TUBERCULOSIS," on July 24, 2007 ("the July 2007 Assignment), to Oregon Health & Science University (hereinafter "OHSU"), 3181 S.W. Sam Jackson Park Road, Portland OR 97201, which July 2007 Assignment was recorded at Reel 019765, Frames 0759-0763 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on August 30, 2007. THE LEWINSOHNS also executed an assignment of U.S. Provisional Patent Application No. 60/782,364 on July 14, 2008 (the "July 2008 Assignment"), to Oregon Health & Science University (hereinafter "OHSU"), 3181 S.W. Sam Jackson Park Road, Portland OR 97201, which Assignment was recorded at Reel 021313, Frames 0372-0376 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on July 30, 2008;

WHEREAS, during the time when THE LEWINSOHNS contributed to the invention disclosed in U.S. Provisional Patent Application No. 60/782,364 and PCT Application No. PCT/US2007/006472, an agreement was in place between OHSU and The Government of the United States of America, dba The Department of Veterans Affairs (hereinafter "the VA"), 810 Vermont Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C., 20420, by which OHSU and the VA were to share ownership of THE LEWINSOHNS rights in the invention;

THEREFORE, in accordance with the agreement, OHSU acknowledges that the VA has been a co-owner of the invention by virtue of the prior agreement, and OHSU hereby transfers an undivided interest PCT Patent Application No. PCT/US2007/006472, including the right to claim priority to the provisional application, to the VA. OHSU has also transferred an undivided interest in U.S. Provisional Patent Application No. 60/782,364 to the VA.
