and under the said improvements and the said application;



NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to me in hand

Commissioner of Patents of the United States, and any Official of any country or countries  
foreign to the United States, whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to  
issue all Letters Patent for said improvements to the said **KGT GRAPHIT TECHNOLOGIE  
GMBH** successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this  
instrument.

AND I HEREBY covenant that I have full right to convey the entire interest herein  
assigned, and that I have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND I HEREBY further covenant and agree that I will communicate to the said **KGT  
GRAPHIT TECHNOLOGIE GMBH** its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any  
facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all  
lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths  
and generally do everything possible to aid the said **KGT GRAPHIT TECHNOLOGIE  
GMBH** its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent  
protection for said improvements in all countries.
