ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is effective as of September 14, and is between

(i) Random Technologies LLC., a Limited Liability Company organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, U.S.A., of 2325 3rd St., San Francisco, CA 94107, USA (hereinafter RANDOM), and

(ii) Amos Gottlieb, a citizen of the United States, of San Francisco, California, USA (hereinafter GOTTLIEB), and William Kilbridge, a citizen of the United States, of Burlingame, California, USA (hereinafter KILBRIDGE), GOTTLIEB and KILBRIDGE being hereinafter collectively referred to as

INVENTORS.

WHEREAS

A. INVENTORS have made an invention or inventions relating to Apparatus for Degassing Liquids (hereinafter INVENTION) as described in United States provisional patent application No. 61/276,610, filed September 14, 2009, by INVENTORS, and in International Patent Application No. PCT/US 2010/002500 filed September 13, 2010, by RANDOM and INVENTORS.

B. INVENTORS, before September 13, 2010, executed an assignment to RANDOM effective as of September 14, 2009, of all right, title and interest in INVENTION insofar as it was described in the Provisional Application No. 61/276,610, including all priority rights derived from that provisional application, and RANDOM accepted that assignment,

C. each of INVENTORS, at the time the INVENTION was made, was under an obligation to assign all of his rights in the invention to RANDOM, and

D. RANDOM wishes to acquire the entire right, title and interest in INVENTION, including but not limited to, all patents and other proprietary rights for INVENTION throughout the world, and each of INVENTORS wishes to assign to RANDOM his entire right, title and interest in INVENTION.

RANDOM and INVENTORS have agreed as follows.

1. Each of INVENTORS, in consideration of the sum of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby assign to RANDOM, its successors and assigns, and RANDOM accepts, his entire right, title and interest in INVENTION, including, but not limited to, any and all applications, including but not limited to, the provisional and international applications listed above and any US non-provisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional or reissue application, and any application in a country other than the United States for Letters Patent, Utility Model or other Proprietary Rights throughout the world for INVENTION, all Priority Rights for INVENTION derived from any such application under International Conventions or otherwise throughout the world, and any and all Letters Patent or other Proprietary Right granted on any such application.

2. Each of INVENTORS covenants that he has the full right to convey the right, title and interest herein assigned, and that he has not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith, and will, at the expense of RANDOM, sign any paper which requires the signature of an inventor for the prosecution of any application for patent or other proprietary right for INVENTION.
