ASSIGNMENT OF PATENT APPLICATION

WHEREAS, WE, JAMES E. BRUNO, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, CHARLES J. SMITH, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, ARTHUR BLANK, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, LEN SCHIEDEL, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, and BOB SERLING, a citizen of THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, (hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNORS"), have invented a certain invention entitled METHOD AND SYSTEM FOR KNOWLEDGE ASSESSMENT AND LEARNING INCORPORATING FEEDBACKS for which application for Letters Patent of the United States of America was filed on April 3, 2002 and assigned U.S. Application Serial Number 10/115,157; and

ASSIGNORS hereby authorize and request the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks and any officials of foreign countries whose duty it is to issue patents or any legal equivalent thereof to said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, in accordance with this Assignment.

ASSIGNORS hereby covenant that no assignment, sale, agreement or encumbrance has been or will be made or entered into which would conflict with this Agreement;

ASSIGNORS further covenant that ASSIGNEE will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to said application, said invention and said Letters Patent and legal equivalents as may be known and accessible to ASSIGNORS and will testify as to the same in any interference or litigation related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to ASSIGNEE or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to apply for, obtain, maintain, issue and enforce said application, said invention and said Letters Patent and said equivalents in the United States or in any foreign country, which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes thereof.
