ASSIGNOR further conveys to the Assignee the right to make application on its own behalf for protection of the invention claimed in U.S. Patent Application No. 10/203,267 in countries foreign to the U.S. and to claim under the Patent Cooperation Treaty, the International Convention and/or other international arrangement for any such application the date of the U.S. application (or any other application, if any) to gain priority with respect to other applications.

ASSIGNOR covenants and agrees with the Assignee that it will not execute any writing or do any act whatsoever conflicting with the terms of this Assignment, and that Assignor will at any time upon request, without further consideration, but at the expense of the Assignee, execute such additional assignments and other writings and do such additional acts as the Assignee may deem necessary or desirable to perfect the Assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, reexamined and reissued patents in the United States, or any and all foreign countries on the invention, and in enforcing any rights or causes of action accruing as a result of such applications or patents, and by executing statements and other affidavits, it being understood that the foregoing covenant and agreement shall bind, and inure to the benefit of, the assigns and legal representatives of all parties hereto.
