ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, **Peter Foster Allen**, whose full post office address is 120 South Gate Drive, Apt. 211, Bedford, Nova Scotia, Canada, B4C 0B1, **Michael Ray Doyle**, whose full post office address is 2 Barkton Lane, Apt. 218, Halifax, Nova Scotia, Canada, B3M 4J6 and **Daniel Mark Bolivar**, whose full post office address is 1 Paul Thomas Drive, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, Canada B2W 6A1 (collectively the "**Inventors**") have made an invention relating to rotating unions (the "**Invention**") for which United States Patent Application No. 12/368870 was filed on February 10, 2009 under the title:

**ROTATING UNION**

AND WHEREAS the **Invention** arose from the Halifax Injector 2<sup>nd</sup> Generation Prototype project (the "**Project**") at **Nova Scotia Community College**, whose address is 80 Mawmi Place, Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, Canada B2Y 0A5 ("**NSCC**");

AND WHEREAS **Peter Foster Allen** and **Michael Ray Doyle**, being at all relevant times students at **NSCC** have previously executed Student Assignment Agreements pursuant to which they acknowledged that all intellectual property rights in inventions arising from the **Project** vest in **NSCC** and pursuant to which they assigned all right, title and interest in and to any and all such inventions to **NSCC**;

AND WHEREAS **Daniel Mark Bolivar** is an employee of **NSCC** under conditions of employment pursuant to which any inventions made in the course of his employment are owned by **NSCC**, and the **Project** was part of the duties of **Daniel Mark Bolivar** as an employee of **NSCC**;

NOW THEREFORE in consideration of the sum of one Canadian dollar (CAD\$1.00) payable by **NSCC** to each of the **Inventors**, for a total of three Canadian dollars (CAD\$3.00) and other good

and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the **Inventors**, individually and collectively, confirm that we have sold, assigned and transferred and do hereby sell, assign and transfer to the said **NSCC**, and assign the whole right, title and interest for the United States of America, Canada, and all other countries and all other places that are not countries, in, to and in respect of the **Invention** and in, to and in respect of all applications and all Letters Patent that may be obtained therefor in the United States of America, Canada, and all other countries and all other places that are not countries, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, reissue, re-examination and Convention applications and any Letters Patent to issue therefrom, together with every priority right that is or may be predicated upon or arise from the **Invention**, the applications and the Letters Patent.


AND, we, the **Inventors**, individually and collectively, hereby authorize **NSCC** to file patent applications in respect of the **Invention** in any countries and in any places that are not countries, and request that the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, the Canadian Commissioner of Patents, and all other patent authorities issue the Letters Patent to **NSCC**, the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to the **Invention** for its sole use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors and assigns, to the full end of the term for which any Letters Patent in respect of the **Invention** may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had this assignment and sale not been made.


AND, we, the **Inventors**, individually and collectively, hereby bind ourselves, our legal representatives and assigns to do, upon **NSCC**'s request, but without additional consideration, all acts reasonably serving to assure that the **Invention**, the said patent applications and the said Letters Patent shall be held and enjoyed by **NSCC** as fully and entirely as the same could have been held and enjoyed by us, our legal representatives and assigns if this assignment had not been made; and particularly to execute and deliver to **NSCC** all lawful application documents including petitions, specifications and oaths, and all assignments, disclaimers and lawful affidavits in form and substance as may be requested by **NSCC**; to communicate to **NSCC** all facts known to us relating to said


inventions and discoveries or the history thereof; and to furnish NSCC with any and all documents, photographs, models, samples and other physical exhibits in our control or in the facts or our conceptions, disclosures, and reduction to practice of the **Invention**.






