Following up to our recent conversation, I am pleased to advise that the Georgia Institute of Technology (GIT) has agreed to release to you and your collaborators ("Assignees") GTRC's rights to the above-mentioned intellectual property.

All commercial rights in the technology, which may be vested in GIT or GTRC, are hereby assigned to you. This release and waiver of rights applies only to GTRC's and GIT's commercial rights in the technology described in the above-mentioned invention disclosure, and not to the rights any other third parties may have. GTRC and GIT shall retain an internal use license to the technology for research and educational purposes, whether alone or with a third party collaborator. Title to any improvements that may arise from the technology and which are conceived and/or developed at GIT shall reside with GTRC.

Please be advised that the conversation(s) you participated with Mr. Paul Frost and GTRC's intellectual property counsel at Troutman Sanders, LLP ("Troutman") regarding the United States patent application 11/473,425 is not covered under attorney-client privilege and, thus, may need to be disclosed to the United States Patent Office. Unfortunately, GTRC was not consulted on the matter at the time but Mr. Frost has been subsequently advised of such and the negative effect it may have on you further pursuing the patent.

Further, GTRC has advised Troutman that we would be willing to execute a conflict waiver, if you choose to engage them to pursue the patent application.

This assignment shall be effective on return to the undersigned of the enclosed copy of this letter signed by you to indicate your acceptance of the assignment.
