ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT


For and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) to us in hand paid, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, INTERTECH SYSTEMS Corporation ("INTERTECH") of Alexandria, Virginia, has sold, assigned, and transferred, and does hereby sell, assign and transfer, unto Motorola, Inc. ("Motorola"), a corporation of the State of Delaware, having its principal office in Schaumburg, State of Illinois, United States of America, and its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, the entire right, title and interest for the United States of America in and to certain inventions in "Distributed Multi-Outlet Paging" (Case No. IRI03023), described, illustrated and claimed in an application for Letters Patent of the United States of America, together with the entire right, title and interest in and to said application, and in and to Letters Patent, which may be issued upon said application, and upon any division, extension, continuation or reissue thereof.

INTERTECH hereby also sells, assigns and transfers unto the said Motorola, Inc., the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention and in and to applications for Letters Patent therefor in all countries foreign to the United States of America, including all rights under any and all international conventions and treaties in respect of said invention and said applications for Letters Patent in foreign countries, and INTERTECH further authorizes the said Motorola, Inc. to apply for Letters Patent in foreign countries directly in its own name, and to claim priority of the filing date of the said application for Letters Patent of the United States of America under the provisions of any and all international conventions and treaties.



INTERTECH agrees that, when requested, it will, without charge for royalty or license to said Motorola, Inc., but at Motorola's expense, sign all papers, take all rightful oaths, and do all acts which may be necessary, desirable or convenient for securing and maintaining patents for said inventions in any and all countries and for vesting title thereto in patents for said inventions in any and all countries and for vesting title thereto in said Motorola, Inc., its successors, assigns and legal representatives or nominees.

INTERTECH covenants with said Motorola, Inc., its successors, assigns and legal representatives, that the interest and property hereby conveyed is free from all prior assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other encumbrance.

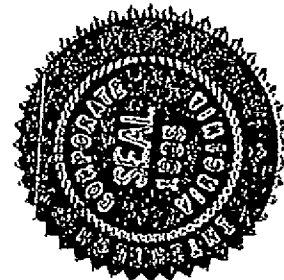


