PATENT RELEASE

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Security Agreement, dated as of November 19, 2010 by and among the Collateral Agent and the other parties thereto (as amended, modified, restated and/or supplemented from time to time, the "Security Agreement") and the Grant of Security Interest in United States Patents, dated November 19, 2010, by and between Grantor and the Collateral Agent (with the Security Agreement, the "Security Documents"), Grantor has heretofore granted to the Collateral Agent a security interest in (i) all of the Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under to the United States patents and patent applications (the "Patents") set forth on Schedule A attached hereto, (ii) all Proceeds and products of the Patents, and (iii) all causes of action arising prior to or after the date hereof for infringement of any of the Patents or unfair competition regarding the same (collectively, the "Patent Collateral"), which security interest was recorded on November 23, 2010 at Reel 025412, Frame 0531 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office; and

WHEREAS, the Collateral Agent wishes to release and restore all right, title and interest in and to the Patent Collateral to Grantor and to dissolve any and all liens and encumbrances respecting the Patent Collateral under the Security Documents.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the Collateral Agent hereby releases, discharges, quit claims and relinquishes unto Grantor its security interest in and lien on any and all right, title and interest in the Patent Collateral. All capitalized terms used but not defined in this Release shall have the meanings ascribed to them in the Security Agreement.
