PATENT ASSIGNMENT

This Patent Assignment ("Assignment") is made and entered into on this ____ day of January 2012, by and between:

Action Technologies, Inc. a California Corporation, having a mailing address at P.O. Box 39, San Leandro, California 94577-0139 ("ASSIGNEE"); and

Guidewire Software, Inc., a Delaware corporation, with a principal place of business at 2211 Bridgepointe Pkwy, San Mateo, California 94404 ("ASSIGNOR").

WHEREAS, ASSIGNOR has agreed to assign and transfer to ASSIGNEE all right, title and interest in and to the Assigned Patent Rights (as defined below).

"Assigned Patent Rights" shall mean: (a) the United States and international patents listed on Attachment A; (b) any United States patents or patent applications to which any of the foregoing patents directly or indirectly claim priority or for which any of the foregoing patents directly or indirectly forms a basis for priority, and/or any applications that incorporate by reference or are incorporated by reference, into the foregoing patents, including, without limitation, the United States and international patent applications (including provisional applications) listed on Attachment A; (c) any direct or indirect divisionals, continuations, continuation-in-part applications and continued prosecution applications (and their relevant international equivalents) of any of the foregoing, and the resulting patents; (d) any patents resulting from reissues, reexaminations or extensions (and their relevant international equivalents, including, without limitation supplementary protection certificates) of the patents described in clauses (a), (b) and (c) above; (e) international (non-United States) patent applications and provisional applications and the relevant international equivalents to divisionals, continuations, continuation-in-part applications and continued prosecution applications of the patents and patent applications referred to in clauses (a), (b), (c) and (d) above, and the resulting patents; (f) inventions, invention disclosures and discoveries described in any of the foregoing that (i) are included in any claim in any of the foregoing; (ii) are subject matter capable of being reduced to a patent claim in a reissue or reexamination proceeding relating to any of the foregoing; or (iii) could have been included as a claim in any of the foregoing; (g) rights to apply in any or all countries of the world for patents, certificates of invention, utility models or other governmental grants or issuances of any type related to any of the foregoing and the inventions, invention disclosures and discoveries therein; and (h) causes of action (whether known or unknown or whether currently pending, filed or otherwise) and other enforcement rights under, or on account of, any of the foregoing, including, without limitation, all causes of action and other enforcement rights for damages, injunctive relief and any other remedies of any kind for past, current or future infringement, and rights to collect royalties or other payments under or on account of any of the foregoing. The foregoing assignment, transfer and conveyance is made to the full end of the term for which the Assigned Patent Rights may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by ASSIGNOR had this assignment and sale not been made and includes all documents related to the conception, diligence and reduction to practice of the inventions disclosed in the Assigned Patent Rights and all domestic and international patent filing documents.

ASSIGNOR does hereby authorize the Director of the United States Patent & Trademark Office, and the empowered officials of all other governments whose duty it is to record patents, applications and title thereto, to record the Assigned Patent Rights and title thereto as the property of ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, or legal representatives in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

ASSIGNOR does hereby further authorize and request the Director of the United States Patent & Trademark Office and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue such patent rights or patents as shall be granted upon the Assigned Patent Rights, or applications based thereon, to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, or legal representatives.

ASSIGNEE and ASSIGNOR also agree that multiple copies of this Assignment may be executed, each of which shall be deemed an original, and each of which shall be valid and binding upon ASSIGNEE and ASSIGNOR. 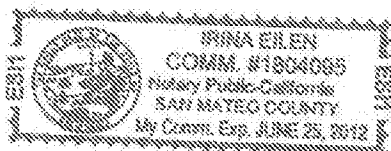
