Pursuant to Section 18-209 of the Limited Liability Company Act of the State of Delaware, the undersigned limited liability company, Fabcon, L.L.C., a limited liability company duly organized under the laws of Delaware (the "Company"), hereby certifies as follows:

FIRST: The name and jurisdiction of formation or organization of each of the constituent entities of the merger are as follows:

The foregoing amendment has been adopted pursuant to § 18-202 of the Delaware Limited Liability Company Act.

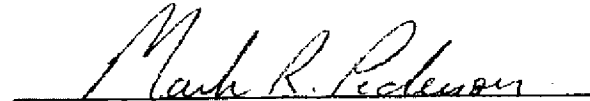
FIFTH: This Certificate of Merger will be effective at 11:59 p.m., Eastern Time, on May 27, 2012.
