Acknowledgment Of Ownership And Assignment

WHEREAS, Milliken & Company ("Milliken") and Dr. Brian Morin were engaged in a dispute over ownership of certain patents, among other things, based upon Dr. Morin's employment agreement with Milliken while he was employed by Milliken, the formation of Innegra, LLC by Morin after his departure from Milliken and several patent applications filed by Innegra, LLC, most of which have matured into the patents listed below;

WHEREAS, in response to a pending foreclosure sale ("UCC sale") of certain assets of Innegra, LLC, Milliken filed an Associate Agreement (Attorney Dkt # Morin Assignment) on August 8, 2011 alleging that Milliken may have some ownership rights in the Patents (as defined below);

WHEREAS, Innegra Technologies, LLC ("Innegra") purchased certain assets, including the Patents, in the UCC sale effective September 9, 2011, and disagrees that Milliken has any ownership interest in the Patents;

WHEREAS, on or about May 18, 2012, Milliken and Innegra entered into a license agreement to resolve their dispute concerning ownership;

NOW THEREFORE, Innegra and Milliken, having resolved their differences, hereby agree to the following:

1. For good and valuable consideration in hand paid, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, and other good and valuable consideration, Milliken, agrees to sell, assign and transfer, and by these presents does sell, assign, and transfer unto Innegra, including its successors and assigns, any and all right, title and interest it may have in and to the patents and patent applications and any direct or indirect application or patent stemming therefrom (collectively, the "Patents"), which include the following:

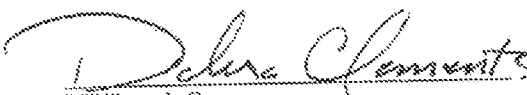
