





FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a cone-capped nail polish bottle according to the design of this invention;

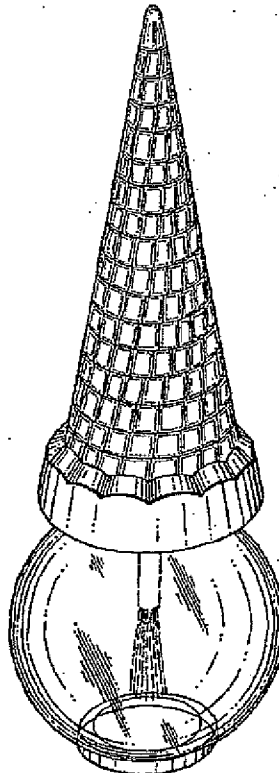
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

The dashed lines throughout the views form no part of the claimed design.

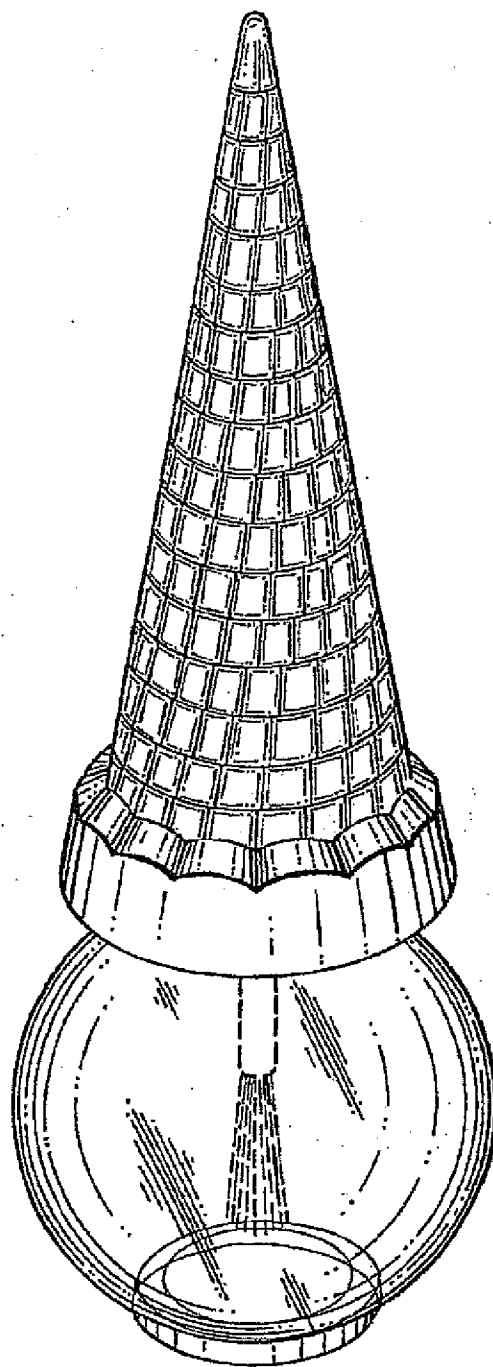

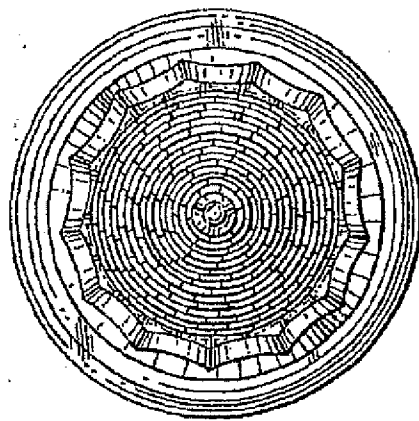

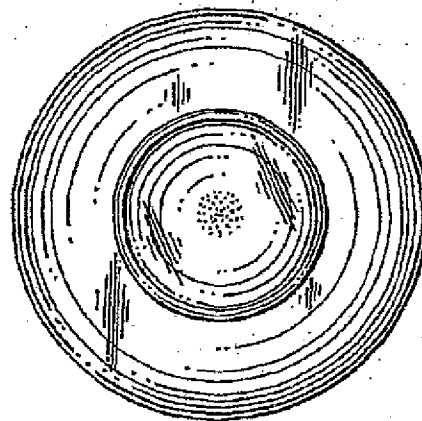
