- 2 Provided that the Assignor does not exclude or limit its liability under this assignment for death or personal injury caused by its negligence or for fraudulent misrepresentation, the Assignor shall not be liable under this assignment, or to the Assignee in relation to the Patents or any act or omission by the licensee or any third party in relation to either of the Patents, whether such liability arises in contract, tort (including without limitation negligence) or otherwise, for loss of business, use, profit, anticipated profit, contracts, revenues, goodwill or anticipated savings or consequential, special or indirect loss or damage, even if the Assignor has been advised of the possibility of such loss or damage.
- 3 All warranties, conditions and guarantees relating to the Patents and this assignment whether express or implied by statute, law, custom or otherwise are, to the fullest extent permitted by law, excluded from this assignment.

- 4 This assignment constitutes the whole agreement between the parties and supersedes all previous agreements between the parties relating to its subject matter.
- 5 Without limitation to clause 3, the Assignee acknowledges that, in entering into this assignment, he has not relied on, and shall have no right or remedy in respect of, any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether made negligently or innocently) other than as expressly set out in this assignment. Nothing in this clause 5 shall limit or exclude any liability for fraud.
- 6 No variation of this assignment shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by the parties (or their authorised representatives).
- 7 This assignment and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of England and Wales.
- 8 The parties irrevocably agree that the courts of England and Wales shall have non-exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this assignment or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).
