Be it known that we have invented a new, original and ornamental design for a Cosmetic
Applicator Tip of which the following is a specification, reference being made to the

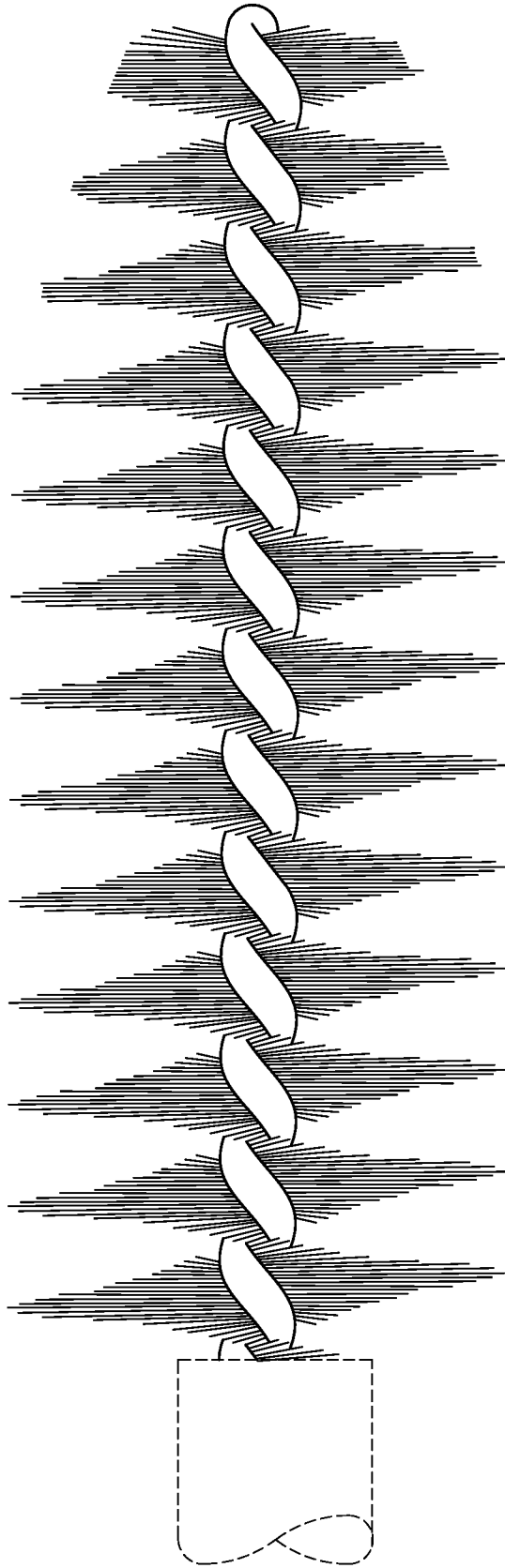

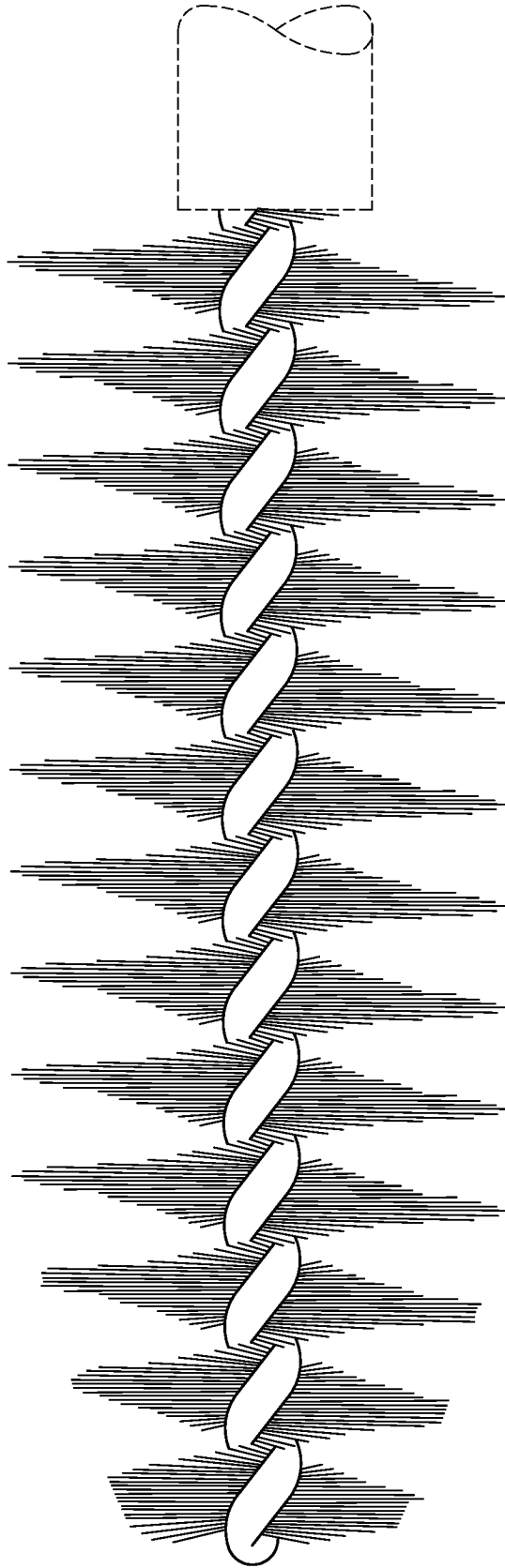

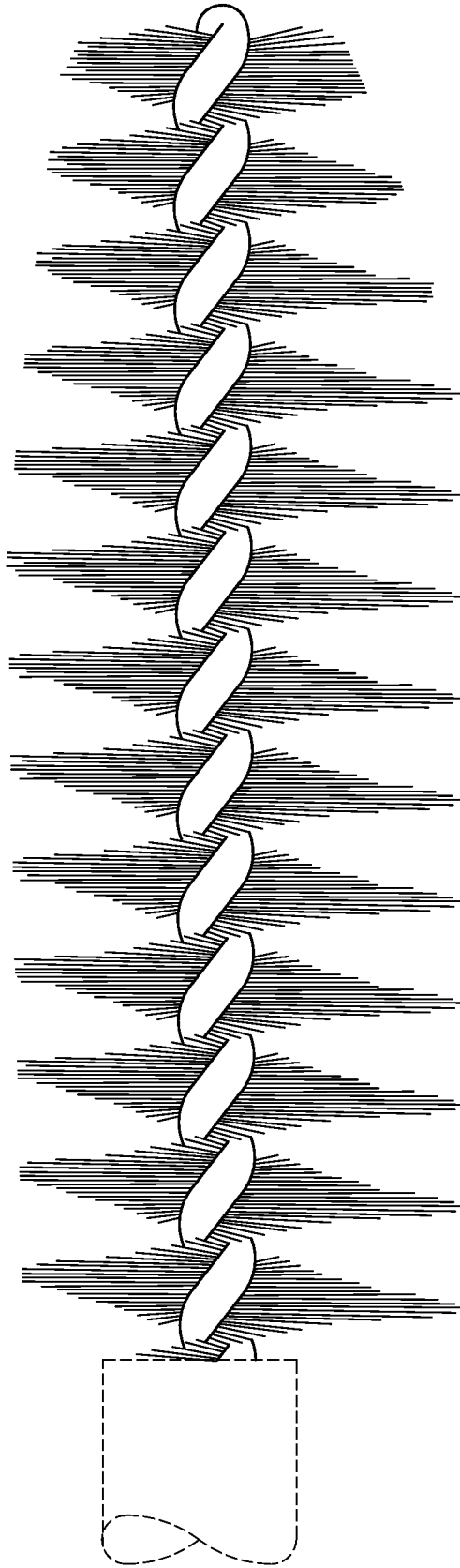

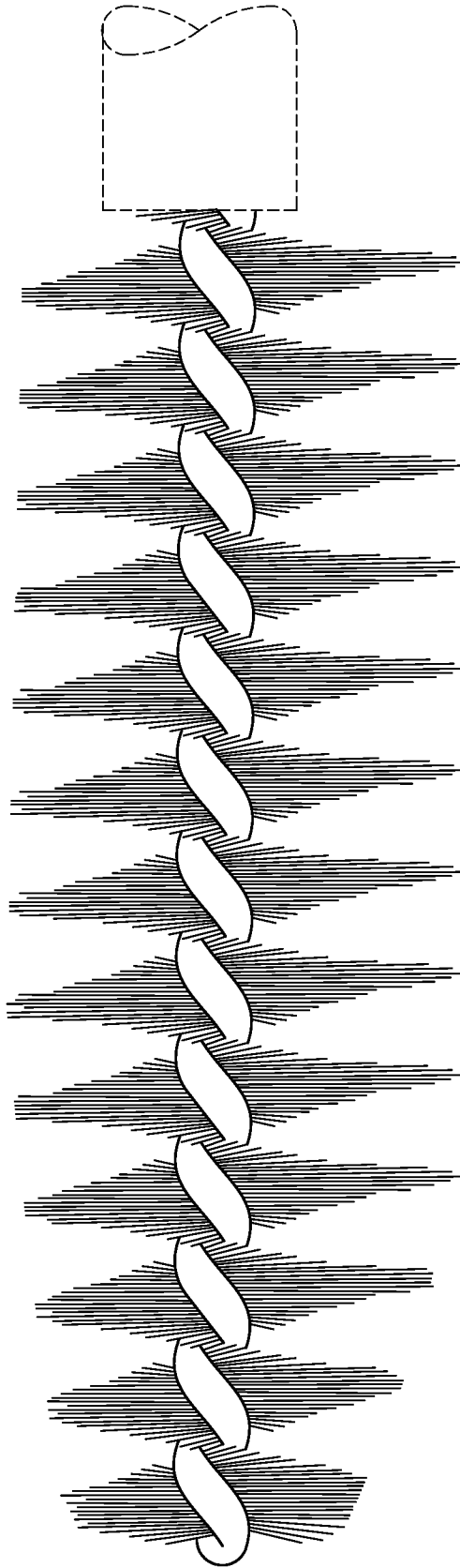

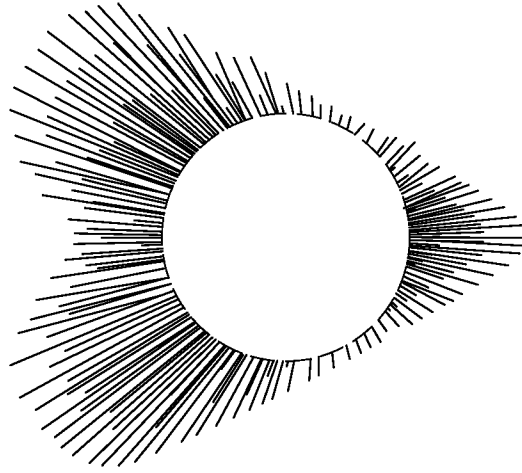

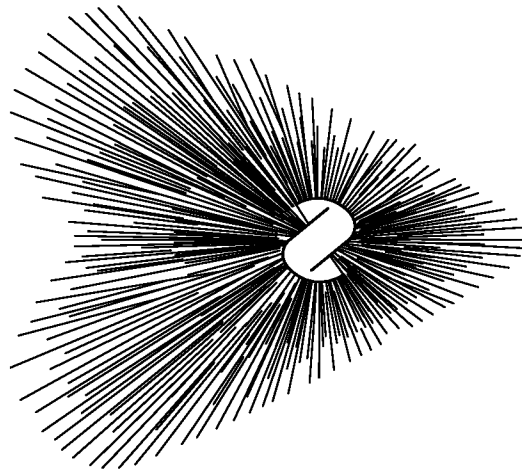
