TRUSTEE'S MOTION TO SELL ESTATE ASSETS FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL
LIENS, CLAIMS, CHARGES, ENCUMBRANCES AND INTERESTS

THIS MOTION SEEKS AN ORDER THAT MAY ADVERSELY AFFECT YOU. IF YOU OPPOSE THE MOTION, YOU SHOULD IMMEDIATELY CONTACT THE MOVING PARTY TO RESOLVE THE DISPUTE. BEN B. FLOYD, the chapter 7 trustee (the "Trustee"), for the bankruptcy estate (the "Estate") of ThromboVision, Inc., hereby files The Trustee's Motion for Authority to Sell Estate Assets Free and Clear of All Liens, Claims, Charges, and Encumbrances (the "Motion"). In support thereof, the Trustee respectfully submits as follows:

I. JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. This Court has jurisdiction over this Motion pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1334. This is a case pending pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(h)(2)(A), (B), and (C). The grounds for the relief requested in the Motion is sections 105, 363(b) and (f) of title 11 of the United States Code, 11 U.S.C. §§ 101-1532 (as amended, the "Bankruptcy Code").

II. BACKGROUND

2. On September 2, 2010 (the "Petition Date"), ThromboVision, Inc. (the "Debtor") filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code.

3. Also on September 2, 2010, Ben B. Floyd was appointed Trustee for the Debtor's Estate.

4. As of the Petition Date, the Debtor owned various trademarks and pieces of equipment and associated technical drawings that were utilized in its business (collectively, the "Assets"). The Assets were listed in the Debtor's bankruptcy schedules. See Debtor's Amended Schedule B22, B8, and B9 (Decket No. 6), a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A". Pursuant to section 541 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Assets became property of the Estate as of the Petition Date.

III. REQUESTED RELIEF

5. Through the Motion, the Trustee seeks the entry of an order authorizing the Trustee to sell the Assets by private sale pursuant to section 363 of the Bankruptcy Code, for \$17,000.00.

6. Subject to this Court's approval, the Trustee intends to sell the Assets on an "as is, where is" basis free and clear of all liens, claims, and encumbrances, pursuant to sections 363(b)(1) and (f) of the Bankruptcy Code. Subsequent to his appointment, the Trustee received

associated with an auction. Accordingly, the Trustee submits that the proposed sale is in the best interests of the Estate and its creditors.

24. CONCLUSIONS

For the reasons set forth herein, the Trustee respectfully requests that the Court enter an Order (i) authorizing the sale of the Assets to Thrombolytic, Inc. for \$17,000.00 pursuant to section 543 of the Bankruptcy Code, (ii) reviving all claims held against the Estate by Thrombolytic, Inc., and (iii) granting the Trustee such order and further relief, both at law and in equity, to which he may lawfully be entitled.

8. Subsequent to the Petition Date, the Trustee, through counsel, has undertaken an investigation of the Assets. As a result of said investigation, the Trustee does not believe that there are any outstanding loans against the Assets. Thus, the net proceeds from the proposed sale will be utilized to pay the Estate's creditors.

9 The terms of the proposed sale of the Equipment are as follows:

- a. Thermobody, Inc. shall pay the Trustee \$17,000.00 (the "Purchase Price") in cash and shall waive all of its claims, if any, against the Estate;
- b. The sale will be free and clear of all liens, claims, charges, and encumbrances pursuant to section 363 of the Bankruptcy Code;
- c. The Trustee makes no representations or warranties regarding the Assets;
- d. The transfer of title to the Assets shall be made by bill of sale; and
- e. The sale is subject to Bankruptcy Court approval.

10. It is the Trustee's best business judgment that the Offer is the highest and best offer for the Assets, which will allow the Estate to realize the fair market value for the Assets and also minimize the Estate's administrative expenses. Moreover, the appraisal prepared by Weinstein's demonstrates that an auction of the Assets would likely result in a significantly lower sales price than the Purchase Price, which would be further reduced by the additional costs
