The Assignor hereby agrees, upon the request and at the expense of said Assignees, their successors and assigns, to execute any and all continuation, continuation-in-part, divisional, extension, renewal, and substitute applications for said invention or improvements, and any necessary oath, affidavit or declaration relating thereto, and any application for the reissue, reexamination, or extension of any Letters Patent that may be granted upon said application, that said Assignees, their successors

or assigns may deem necessary or expedient; and to cooperate to the best of the ability of the Assignor with said Assignees, their successors and assigns, in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents, including the preparation and execution of preliminary statements, giving and producing evidence, and performing any and all other acts necessary to obtain said Letters Patent in the United States, and vest all rights therein hereby conveyed in the Assignees, their successors and assigns, whereby said Letters Patent will be held and enjoyed by the said Assignees, their successors and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent will be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by the Assignor if this Assignment had not been made.
