EXTINGUISHMENT OF 2005 PATENT LICENSE

This extinguishment of the August 29, 2005 patent license is made by and among the following parties:

United Coin Machine Co., a Nevada corporation, hereinafter referred to, together with its respective predecessors, successors, assigns, trustees, agents, administrators, employees, officers, directors, agents, both past and present as "United Coin"; and

International Game Technology, a Nevada corporation, hereinafter referred to, together with its respective predecessors, successors, assigns, trustees, agents, administrators, employees, officers, directors, agents, both past and present as "IGT"; and

Gaming Technology Group, a Nevada corporation, hereinafter referred to, together with its respective predecessors, successors, assigns, trustees, agents, administrators, employees, officers, directors, agents, both past and present as "GTG."

WHEREAS, Century Gaming, Inc., United Coin, and Western Money Systems ("WMS") entered into a certain Patent License on or about August 2005 ("Patent License");

WHEREAS, GTG claims WMS's rights in and to the Patent License were transferred to GTG;

WHEREAS, IGT and GTG both claim the Patent License provided IGT and GTG a worldwide exclusive license to make, use, offer to sell, sell, import or export the inventions described and claimed in U.S. Patent Numbers 6,763,998 and 6,896,180;


WHEREAS, IGT filed the Patent License with the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO") on October 9, 2009 as found at Reel/Frame 023660/0269;

WHEREAS, Century Gaming and United Coin claim that the Patent License was intended to be and was in practice non-exclusive to IGT and WMS and that GTG has never had any rights under the Patent License;


WHEREAS, Century Gaming, United Coin, IGT and GTG, by signing separate settlement agreements and non-exclusive patent licenses, have resolved any and all possible issues and disputes between them regarding the Patent License;

WHEREAS, United Coin, IGT and GTG now desire to provide notice to the world that the Patent License that was filed by IGT on October 9, 2009 has been extinguished;


