AND, we, the said ASSIGNORS, do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents to issue the said Letters Patent of the United States to said ASSIGNEE as the assignee of the whole right, title, and interest in and to the same, for the sole use and behoof of said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns.




the Protection of Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may hereafter be substituted for it.


