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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, Gilles Cattacin, a citizen of France residing at 30, rue de Thann, 68000 Colmar, France; Pierre Laurent, a citizen of France residing at 10, route des 3 Epis, 68320 Turckheim, France; Julien Marietta-Tondin a citizen of France residing at 15 b, rue du Marechal Joffre, 67390 Marckolsheim, France and Remy Ruppel a citizen of France residing at 6, rue des Vosges, 68320 Durrenentzen, France ("Assignors") jointly with Ann M. Andres a citizen of the United States of America residing at 1604 Pond View View Court, Neenah, Wisconsin 54956; and Abby C. Case, a citizen of the United States of America residing at 2700 Forest Haven Court, Green Bay, Wisconsin 54313, have invented certain new and useful improvements in "METHOD FOR MANUFACTURING A SHEET PRODUCT FOR USE IN A DISPENSER AND STRIP OF SHEET PRODUCT" for which we filed an application for letters patent of the United States on January 26, 2012, and which was accorded Serial No. 13/359,254 ("Application"); and

AND ASSIGNORS HEREBY authorize and request the Commissioner for Patents or any other proper officer or agency of any country whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as described above, to issue all said letters patent to GPF, as assignee;

AND ASSIGNORS HEREBY warrant and covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned and that we have not executed and will not execute any instrument or assignment in conflict with this Assignment;

AND ASSIGNORS HEREBY agree to communicate to GPF or its representatives any facts known to us respecting said invention and/or Application, to execute all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reexamination, reissue and foreign applications, sign all lawful documents and make all rightful oaths and declarations relating to said invention and/or Application, and to testify in any judicial or administrative proceeding and generally do everything possible to aid GPF to secure full and complete protection for the invention and/or Application or that may be necessary to vest in GPF the complete title to the invention and/or Application hereby conveyed and to enable it to record said title and enforce said letters patent in the United States of America or any foreign country when requested so to do by GPF.
