**TERMINATION AND RELEASE
OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS**

THIS TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS dated as of December 19, 2012, from General Electric Capital Corporation, a Delaware corporation ("GE Capital"), in its capacity as administrative agent (in such capacity, together with its successors and permitted assigns, the "Agent"), in favor of Aromatic Technologies, Inc. ("Grantor").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Borrower Security Agreement dated as of May 13, 2004 (as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time (the "Security Agreement"), the Patent Security Agreement, dated as of May 13, 2004 (the "First Patent Security Agreement") and the Patent Security Agreement, dated as of June 27, 2005 (the "Second Patent Security Agreement") in favor of Antares Capital Corporation (the "Original Agent"), a Lien on and security interest in (the "Security Interest") was granted by Grantor to the Original Agent in all of such Grantor's right, title and interest in, to and under the Patent Collateral as defined in the First and Second Patent Security Agreements;

WHEREAS, pursuant to certain Assignments of Patent Security Agreement dated as of December 17, 2010 (the "Assignments of Patent Security Agreement"), the Original Agent transferred all of its rights, title and interests in and to the First and Second Patent Security Agreements to Agent;

WHEREAS, the First Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the Assignment Division of the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") on Reel 015341, Frame 0020 on May 13, 2004;

WHEREAS, the Second Patent Security Agreement was recorded with the Assignment Division of the USPTO on Reel 016206, Frame 0136 on June 30, 2005;

WHEREAS, the Assignments of Patent Security Agreement were recorded with the Assignment Division of the USPTO on Reel 025526, Frame 0553 and Reel 025526, Frame 0615 on December 20, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Agent now desires to terminate and release the entirety of its Security Interest in the Patent Collateral;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, including the satisfaction of all obligations, indebtedness and liabilities secured by the Patent Collateral pursuant to the Security Agreement and the First and Second Patent Security Agreements, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, and upon the terms set forth in this Termination and Release, Agent hereby states as follows:

1. Definitions. All capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein have the meanings given to them in the Security Agreement and the First and Second Patent Security Agreements.

2. Release of Patent Security Interest. Agent hereby (i) terminates, releases, and discharges its Security Interest in the Patent Collateral, including, without limitation, the Patents listed in Exhibit I attached hereto, (ii) terminates the First and Second Patent Security Agreements and (iii) re-assigns to Grantor any right, title and interest it may have in, to and under the Patent Collateral. Any and all right, title, or interest of Agent in, to, and under such Patent Collateral and all proceeds thereof, including, without limitation, any and all causes of action which may exist by reason of infringement of the Patent Collateral, shall hereby cease and become void.

3. Further Assurances. Agent hereby agrees to duly execute, acknowledge, procure, and deliver any further documents and to do such other acts as may be reasonably requested by Grantor to effect the release of the Security Interest in the Patent Collateral contemplated hereby.

4. Governing Law. This TERMINATION AND RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST IN PATENTS shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.
