Assignor hereby authorizes and requests such Patent Office officials affiliated with the International Bureau of WIPO and duly authorized under the PCT to prosecute any PCT application on said inventions for the benefit of the Assignee, as the owner of all rights, title, and interests in and to said inventions, for the sole use and benefit of Assignor, its successors, assigns and legal representatives.



This assignment and agreement shall be binding upon Assignor, its successors, affiliates and legal representatives.


