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ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Paul S. Nielsen of 3 Stable Lane, Saratoga Springs, New York invented certain new and useful improvements generally referred to as the **System and Method for an Electronic Gift Key**, hereafter the Improvements, disclosed in various patent documents including the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of one (1) U.S. dollar, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I have sold, assigned, transferred, and set over, and do hereby sell, assign, transfer, and set over to Assignee the entire right, title, and interest in and to (together with the right to sue and recover for past, present, and future infringement) said Improvements, said patent, and said applications and all non-provisionals, divisions, substitutions, continuations, continuations-in-part, and PCTs claiming priority thereof, and all United States Letters Patents which may be granted thereon and all reissues and extensions thereof, and all priority rights under the International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property for every member country, all applications for patents (including related rights such as utility-model registrations, inventor's certificates, and the like) heretofore or hereafter filed for said Improvements in any foreign countries, and all patents (including all extensions, renewals, and reissues thereof) granted for said Improvements in any foreign countries; and I hereby authorize and request the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and any officials of foreign countries whose duty it is to issue patents on applications as aforesaid, to issue all patents for said Improvements to Assignee in accordance with the terms of this assignment;

AND I HEREBY covenant that I have, to the best of my knowledge, full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and I have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

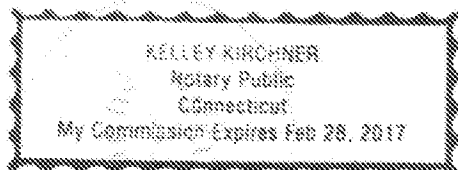
