WHEREAS, Joshua R. Smith and Liang-Ting Jiang have made a certain invention in ACOUSTIC PROXIMITY SENSING for which Joshua R. Smith and Liang-Ting Jiang have executed an application for Letters Patent filed in the U.S. Patent Office on October 29, 2012, as Application No. 13/663355; and

Smith and Liang-Ting Jiang will, at the request and expense of said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization, execute such other and further assurances of title as may be necessary or proper to fully convey the interest herein sought to be conveyed; that Joshua R. Smith and Liang-Ting Jiang will, at the request and expense of said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization, execute such application papers as may be desired by said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization for the filing of any continuation, division, or renewal of the application herein conveyed, or for reissues or extensions of any Letters Patent that may be granted upon said application, and will execute such supplemental oaths and preliminary statements or other papers as desired by said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization.

And Joshua R. Smith and Liang-Ting Jiang further assign unto said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization the entire right and title to and interest in said invention throughout all countries foreign to the United States, and do hereby authorize said University of Washington through its Center for Commercialization to apply for international patents and patents therefor in its own name in countries where such procedure is proper and to claim the benefit of the International Convention, and do agree to execute applications for said invention in the several countries where it is necessary that the same be executed by the
