the right to sue, counterclaim and recover for past, present and future infringement of the Patents and the rights thereto.

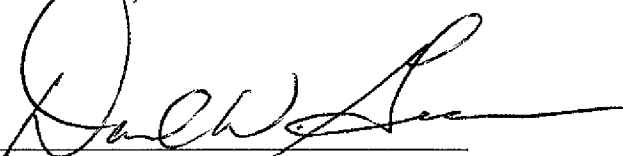

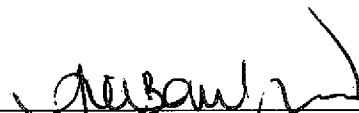
