Assignment

Such cooperation by the Assignor shall include (a) prompt production of pertinent facts and documents, giving testimony, execution of petitions, oaths, specifications, declarations or other papers, and other assistance all to the extent deemed necessary or desirable by the Assignee for perfecting in the Assignee the right, title and interest herein conveyed; (b) for prosecuting any reexaminations or reissues of the Patent; (c) for interference or other priority proceedings involving the Invention disclosed in Patent; and (d) for legal proceedings involving said Invention and any application therefor and any Patents granted thereon, including without limitation opposition proceedings, cancellation proceedings, priority contests, public use proceedings, infringement actions and court actions; provided, however, that the expense incurred by said Assignor in providing such cooperation shall be paid for by said Assignee, at the sole discretion of Assignor.

3. The term and covenants of this agreement shall inure to the benefit of said Assignee, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, and shall be binding upon said Assignor, its legal representatives and assigns.

4. Assignor hereby warrants and represents that they have not entered and will not enter into any assignment, contract, or understanding in conflict herewith.
