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CONSENT IN LIEU OF SPECIAL SHAREHOLDER MEETING OF
ELECTROCHROMIX, INC.

Pursuant to the Shareholder Agreement of Electrochromix, Inc. (the "Company") and ARS Section 10-732, the undersigned, holding a majority of the Shares in the Company that are entitled to vote, hereby consent to the adoption of the following resolutions in lieu of holding a Special Meeting:

Dissolution:

RESOLVED, that the Company take all necessary steps to dissolve the Company and windup its affairs.

Return of LANL License

RESOLVED, that in accordance with the previous resolution that the Company shall relinquish all rights under the EXCLUSIVE PATENT LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN LOS ALAMOS NATIONAL SECURITY, LLC AND ELECTROCRMIX, INC. (the "License") and terminate the License. The License constitutes of license agreement No. 09-C02572 and any prior agreements and modifications (LANL Document Control No. 03-C01399, executed May 21, 2003, as well as all subsequent License Modification Agreements 1, 2, and 3)

Sale Of Other Intellectual Property to AJJER

RESOLVED, that the Company enter into an agreement with AJJER, LLC to sell all its remaining intellectual property not including the License to AJJER, LLC. Such intellectual property shall include, but is not limited to, any patents, licenses or research related to any intellectual property the Company may own as more fully described on Exhibit A hereto in exchange for AJJER, LLC paying the sum of \$12,222.21 ("Payment Amount") to the company over a twelve month period in twelve equal installments. Such payments will be distributed to the following shareholders by the Company: Robert LeCompte, Anthony Burrell, Ben Warner and Mark McCleskey. Alternatively AJJER may pay such sums directly to these shareholders. The Payment will be paid so that Ben Warner receives \$2,222.22 in total payments and Robert LeCompte, Anthony Burrell, and Mark McCleskey each shall receive \$3,333.33 in total payment. Such payment to Robert LeCompte, Anthony Burrell, Ben Warner and Mark McCleskey will constitute repayment of loans made by them to the Company. In addition as further consideration for the purchase of the intellectual property Anoop Agrawal, John Cronin and Juan Carlos Tonazzi the principals of AJJER, LLC will recognize the transfer of the intellectual property to AJJER as repayment of loans in the amount of \$16,666.65 that they collectively made to the Company in equal amounts of \$5,555.55 each.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the officers of the Company be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to execute an agreement providing for the sale of the intellectual property as described above to AJJER, LLC.

RESOLVED, that pursuant to ARS Section 10-863 that provides Shareholders' action is effective respecting any transaction where a director or directors have conflicting interests that the resolution contained herein shall constitute instructions to the officers of the Company and the Directors of the Company to take all actions necessary to cause the actions described in these resolutions to be completed.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that each of the Directors has conflicting interests with regard to the actions described herein and as a result Shareholders' action is appropriate.


