## CONFIRMATION AND ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, American Coating Technology, Inc., a Wisconsin corporation which was administratively or involuntarily dissolved on or about May 13, 2009 ("ACT"), is authorized to take such action as is appropriate to wind up and liquidate its business and affairs under Wisconsin Statutes § 180.1405.

WHEREAS, on or about February 3, 2003, ACT conveyed, granted and assigned to Jodi A. Schwendimann (f/k/a Jodi A. Dalvey) ("Schwendimann") for good and valuable consideration, all right, title and interest for all countries in and to all inventions and improvements disclosed in U.S. Patent Application 09/661,532 (the "'532 Application") and in and to the '532 Application, all divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, or renewals thereof, all Letters Patent which may be granted therefrom, and all reissues or extensions of such patents, and in and to any and all applications which have been or shall be filed in any foreign countries for Letters Patent on said inventions and improvements, including an assignment of all rights under the provisions of the International Convention, and all Letters Patent of foreign countries which may be granted therefrom (the "Original Assignment").

WHEREAS, the '532 Application has resulted in issuance of U.S. Patent No. 6,753,050.

WHEREAS, U.S. Patent No. 6,753,050, the inventions described and claimed therein, all corresponding domestic and foreign applications including any provisional, non-provisional, divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue, or any other application based thereon or the inventions described therein, all Letters Patent or similar legal protection issuing thereon, and all rights and benefits under any applicable treaty or convention, shall be referred to herein as the "Invention".

WHEREAS, third parties have challenged in court filings whether certain assignments made by ACT to Schwendimann were legally effective.

WHEREAS, ACT previously sought and intended to convey, grant and assign to Schwendimann, all right, title, and interest in and to the '532 Application and all inventions described and claimed therein, and whereas ACT received sufficient value for that conveyance, grant and assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, ACT agrees and states as follows.

**Confirmation of Prior Assignment**

ACT hereby acknowledges and confirms that it intended to, and did in fact, previously convey, grant and assign to Schwendimann, her successors and assigns, effective as of February 3, 2003, for good and valuable consideration which was received and sufficient, all right, title and interest for all countries in and to all inventions and improvements disclosed in the '532 Application and in and to the '532 Application, all divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, or renewals thereof, all Letters Patent which may be granted therefrom, and all reissues or extensions of such patents, and in and to any and all applications which have been or shall be filed in any foreign countries for Letters Patent on said inventions and improvements, including an assignment of all rights under the provisions of the International Convention, and all Letters Patent of foreign countries which may be granted therefrom.

**Assignment**

To the extent it has not previously conveyed, granted and assigned to her, or to the extent that any prior conveyance, grant or assignment is deemed inoperative or ineffective, ACT now hereby does convey, grant and assign to Schwendimann, her successors and assigns, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged: a)

the entire right, title, and interest in and to the Invention; b) the right to collect royalties, recover damages, and sue for past, present and future infringement of the Invention; and c) the right to collect royalties, recover damages, and sue for all acts of infringement of the Invention occurring prior to the effective date of this assignment. The effective date of this assignment shall be the earlier of the date on which this Assignment and Confirmation is executed, or nunc pro tunc any earlier date, including but not limited to February 3, 2003, as may be permitted by law. In addition, ACT authorizes Schwendimann, her successors and assigns or anyone she may properly designate, to apply for Letters Patent or similar legal protection, in their own name if desired, in the U.S. and any and all foreign countries and to make a claim of priority to any applications as entitled under U.S. law or applicable international conventions, treaties, or otherwise.

**No Conflicting Assignments**

ACT has not executed or performed any act, and shall not execute any writing or perform any act conflicting with this Confirmation and Assignment. ACT will at any time upon request, without additional consideration, but at the expense of the Schwendimann, execute such additional writings and do such additional acts as Schwendimann and her successors and assigns, may deem desirable to perfect her enjoyment of this grant, and render all assistance in making application for and obtaining, maintaining, and enforcing the Letters Patent or similar legal protection on the invention in any and all countries.
