ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Seng-Tiong Ho, hereinafter called the "Assignee", has made the inventions described in the United States Patent Application: Provisional Application 60/406,704, filed August 28, 2002, entitled "Varying Refractive Index Optical Medium Using at Least Two Materials with Thickness Less Than a Wavelength"; and

The Assignor hereby covenants and agrees, for both the Assignor and the Assignor's legal representatives, that the Assignor will assist the Assignee in the prosecution of the patent application identified above; in the making and prosecution of any other patent applications that


